Getting or spreading coronavirus by not sanitising/washing hands or not washing them adequately	Club members	Club members required to have their own sanitising gel/wipes	Sanitising facilities required at main entrance (members to use their own materials) Strongly advise members not to handle models or equipment belong to others, or if this is unavoidable, to sanitise immediately	Individual members	Before 29 March 2021
Getting or spreading coronavirus by contact with shared equipment	Club members	Members advised not to share their equipment during pandemic Common surfaces include main entrance gate and padlock	Remind people to sanitise before and after contact with shared equipment Members to clean surfaces and equipment after use and before leaving.	Individual members	On each occasion
Test and Trace	Club members	Members to email chairman@ivinghoe.org.uk stating date/time whenever visiting the field as part of test and trace	Members are reminded of need to email before visiting	Members wanting to attend field send email to chairman@ivinghoe.org.uk	Each time attending field
